
COMMUNITY PARTNERS: WORKING TOGETHER FOR UNINSURED FAMILIES

FROM DIAGNOSIS TO RECOVERY

Albert was nearly at the end of his rope and had endured several difficulties with his personal life and health. He eventually listened to his mother's advice and came to the Clearwater Free Clinic for treatment to gain control over his health issues and get his life back on track. However, transportation to and from his appointments proved to be a real challenge. The bus pass program, funded by a grant from the North Pinellas Woman's Club, was implemented to assist with patient transportation. This program allowed him to eliminate this hardship and continue to receive much needed care from the CFC.

Prior to receiving care at the Clinic, Albert's symptoms were inconclusive and did not lead to a diagnosis. The results of Albert's lab tests, ordered by the Clinic and provided by Baycare, revealed abnormalities that required immediate follow-up care. During the Clinic appointment that followed, irregularities with his heart led to a recommendation from Clinic nurse practitioners to have him visit the ER. Ultimately, Albert was admitted to the hospital with a blood infection, endocarditis. Not only was the blood infection a very serious concern, but a damaged heart valve meant he needed open heart surgery as soon as possible.

The coronary artery bypass procedure was a success and Albert is now in recovery and no longer smoking. His mother, also a CFC patient, says with relief, "The help he received here saved his life!" The expertise of the Clearwater Free Clinic staff combined with the willingness of the community to embrace our mission creates life-saving results.

ELECTRONIC MEDICAL RECORDS IMPROVE HEALTH CARE

VOLUNTEERS MAKE ALL THE DIFFERENCE!



Along with the move into the new CFC building came the implementation of new technology that is now essential to our day-to-day operations! Electronic medical records (EMR) have been the industry standard for patient record keeping and clinical workflow for years, and now the Clearwater Free Clinic has been brought up to speed with the help of grant awards from CVS Caremark Foundation and the Florida Association of Free and Charitable Clinics combined with the Lewis G. Schaeneman, Jr. Foundation. This grant funding helped to provide the technology, training, equipment, and consulting required to make this transition possible.

To say that this program has the capability to streamline clinical operations is an understatement! The roughly 30,000 prescriptions per year that are dispensed through our facility no longer require hand written labels; these labels are able to be printed with ease through EMR. Additionally, nurse practitioners and volunteer physicians can seamlessly communicate with our network of community partners through the system, expediting patient care and follow-up.

Clinical volunteers have stepped up to the plate and worked hard to make the dream of EMR a reality at our Clinic. "We are so proud of our volunteers for their patience and determination in learning the new EMR system," says Volunteer Coordinator Susan Murbach. Thank you to our volunteers, staff and partners in health for helping to make this transition possible!
