She decided to further her education by enrolling in the Dental Assistant program at the Ultimate Medical Academy.

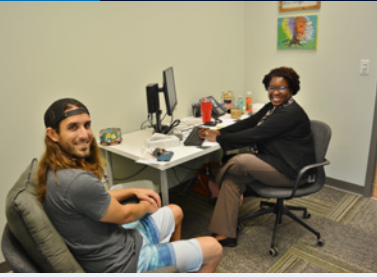
Unfortunately, Tamika encountered obstacles related to numerous health issues that were neglected because she was uninsured with no ability to pay. It was a friend of Tamika's who told her about the Clearwater Free Clinic. Through the Clinic's team of medical and behavioral health providers, Tamika now receives ongoing treatment that will allow her to pursue her next life's goal.

Tamika worked hard to overcome her many obstacles and it paid off. When she graduated from her program with honors, she was asked to be a speaker at her graduation. Her story was so compelling that she was featured on both Channel 8 and Channel 10 newscasts.

"While I have struggled to make a better life for me and my family, the CFC has treated my mind and my body when nobody else would," says Tamika. "I love the Clearwater Free Clinic, and just don't think I could have done what I've done without having them in my corner."

SCOTT'S STORY

After a trip to the emergency room followed by a lengthy stay at Morton Plant Hospital, physicians discovered that Scott had a defective heart valve that needed to be replaced.

Not able to afford private health insurance, he was referred to the Clearwater Free Clinic for continued care. Working with Nurse Practitioner Darlene, he was able to get approved for a TAVR (Trans Aortic Valve Replacement) procedure, at no cost to him! Unfortunately, while waiting for the needed approvals, Scott was diagnosed with squamous cell skin cancer of the ear. This condition could not be treated until the TAVR procedure was completed. Moffitt Cancer Center, a community partner of the CFC, then agreed to perform the cancer surgery. Losing an earlobe did not bother Scott at all. “If it was good enough for Van

Gogh, it’s good enough for me,” Scott said with a smile that lit up the room. “Darlene and the entire staff are just amazing! I am so much more than just a patient to them, I am a person. I will be forever grateful – they have saved my life!”

Despite the multiple health issues Scott has faced, his attitude toward life could not be more positive. “When the road ahead of you is shorter than the road behind, if you are not smiling you are wasting the gift you’ve been given.” Thanks to the Clearwater Free Clinic, the road ahead of Scott can be long indeed!

PATRICIA'S STORY

Patricia is so thankful for her care at the CFC that she created a Facebook Fundraiser for us!

“Having had no medical insurance for the last 4 years, I have been treated by the Clearwater Free Clinic at no cost. They do ask for donations when you are seen, but there is never a ‘required’ payment. 2 years ago I went in for my 6 month check-up for my AFib. While in the exam room with my doctor, I went into AFib and didn’t know it. She happened to be giving me an EKG and saw that I was in AFib. She said she couldn’t let me go home and that they were calling an ambulance to take me to the hospital. I kept telling her I’d be fine, but she wouldn’t take no for an answer... If not for her insistence, I probably would

have passed out in my car and caused someone (as well as myself) damage. The doctors and staff here are amazing and I have been treated with the utmost dignity. They did everything in their power to make my health issues manageable while providing resources to financially assist with prescriptions. I can’t say enough good things about the CFC. I am grateful for the CFC, my ARNP, my cardiologist and the staff who go out of their way to meet the needs of those uninsured. The doctors are VOLUNTEERS. Their true compassion and caring shines through everything they do.”

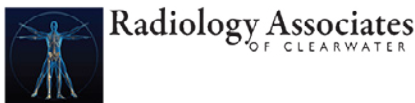
