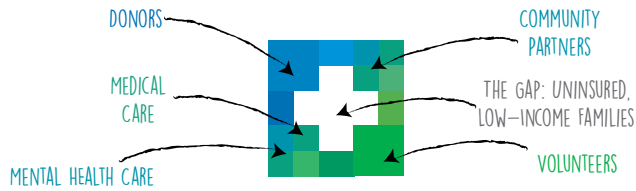


SHOUT OUT TO THE LIONS CLUB!

EXCEEDING EXPECTATIONS!



Rick can hardly remember a time before the Clearwater Free Clinic. As a longtime fisherman in the Clearwater area, Rick had no access to affordable health insurance through his work. He sought out the Clinic's care a few years ago when he was between jobs and ineligible for Medicaid.

"The Clearwater Free Clinic staff and volunteers always treat you with respect, not like you are looking for a hand out."

He initially visited the Clinic for a chronic condition. However, based on his symptoms, a volunteer cardiologist diagnosed Rick with arrhythmia, a potentially dangerous heart condition. Through the Clinic, he was able to receive medications to help improve his condition and also receive preventative care.

Because Rick was finally able to get health insurance he no longer needs the care of the Clinic. He remains the self-proclaimed biggest fan of the Clearwater Free Clinic.

He now trusts the Clinic with his daughter's health care needs; she is one of our newest patients and will likely be treated by some of the same nurses and doctors that provided him with the superior health care that dramatically improved his quality of life.

The new Clearwater Free Clinic facility will provide:

A UNIFIED, CENTRALLY-LOCATED CAMPUS

- Single building campus in a safe, welcoming environment
- Integrated primary care, specialty care, behavioral health services, education and wellness programs
- Dramatic increase in Clinic visibility
- Improved accessibility, especially for patients using public transportation

INCREASED NUMBER OF EXAM & SPECIALTY ROOMS

- 11 regular exam rooms – double the present number to serve patients more efficiently
- 3 specialty exam rooms with essential medical equipment to expand programs
- Additional multipurpose procedure room

DESIGNATED EDUCATION/COMMUNITY SPACE

- Larger private space for wellness classes and patient education
- Volunteer training and Clinic meetings
- Increased opportunities for community use

ENHANCED BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROGRAM

- Double behavioral health counseling rooms
- More behavioral health appointments available
- Improved scheduling allows counselor and nurse practitioner to collaborate on patient care

EXPANDED MEDICATION ROOM

- Larger workspace allows for more volunteers
- Increased dispensing efficiency and decreased patient wait times
- Enhanced technology to maximize accessibility of clinical information for physicians and prevent medication errors

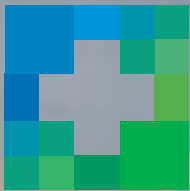
