BUILDING A HEALTHY COMMUNITY LEGACY SOCIETY



CLEARWATER FREE CLINIC AND TOBACCO FREE FLORIDA HELP SMOKERS QUIT

In keeping with the Clearwater Free Clinic's ideal to heal those in need and build healthy communities, we have partnered with Tobacco Free Florida to help smokers rid of their dependence on tobacco. On Monday evenings for six consecutive weeks, the CFC hosts classes in our community room taught by Tobacco Free Florida instructors as part of our expanded community education initiative. The classes are free as well as the patches, nicotine gum and lozenges offered to all participants. The students are not pressured to throw their cigarettes away or quit immediately, but are provided proven techniques to help people quit smoking when they are ready.

Elvin Collazo Torres was ready. He tried to stop several years ago, but couldn't do it on his own. "I smoked at least a pack and a half a day, but now? Zero! Using the patches and the gum has been a great help – they take away the craving. Thank you Tobacco Free Florida and the Clearwater Free Clinic!"



In addition, participants also receive valuable information regarding ways to improve their overall health and learn the financial benefits tied to kicking the habit.
