Bruce Gets the Support He Needs Through CFC Programs & Partners

Last year, Bruce ended up at Morton Plant Hospital with atrial fibrillation due to an enlarged heart, causing heart failure. Once his condition was under control, it was very important that he received proper follow up care, which included physician surveillance, medications and labs. The hospital referred Bruce directly to the CFC for the care of his diabetes, heart disease and inadequate circulation. This intervention has proven to keep those with serious health problems out of the Emergency Department and avoid re-admissions.

Bruce works long hours at Wawa and does not earn enough to afford private health insurance. Through the Clinic's compassionate care and attention, he can now make his health a priority and is getting back on track! Here at the Clinic, Bruce receives his medications, bloodwork, wound care and more! Through our valued partnership with HEP, he was even able to get highly overdue dental work done. He is so grateful and shows much appreciation to the clinicians who provide his care. We are all rooting for you Bruce and are glad we can work together with you and our partners!

AMERICAN HEART MONTH AT THE CFC



February is Heart Month, and it is important to observe this health holiday each year because of how prevalent and preventable heart disease can be! As the leading cause of death for both men and women in the United States. it is important that we all are aware of ways to keep our hearts in good shape by leading a healthy lifestyle and knowing warning signs of heart issues. Stay educated and spread knowledge to family, friends and colleagues!

CFC HOSPITAL REFERRAL PROGRAM CONTINUES TO IMPACT PATIENT SUCCESS

What began as a grant-funded, pilot program is thriving & making a big difference! The hospital referral program, a coordinated effort between the CFC and local hospitals, has become essential to ensure those who are uninsured and low-income receive proper care following a hospital admission, reducing their chances of readmission. The purpose of the program is to identify hospitalized, uninsured patients and facilitate their transition to the CFC for follow-up acute and chronic care management.

Here's how it works! A designated hospital team member, who has been educated on Clearwater Free Clinic eligibility requirements and program services, meets with the patient to determine if they are eligible for CFC assistance. Next is to review post hospital follow-up needs, and assist them with their transition to the CFC - all before discharge from the hospital! Finally, the hospital team member communicates the referral to the Clinic and makes arrangements for the initial follow-up appointment.

Through this program, patients are provided uninterrupted health care and are established into a medical home. The success of this program has shown radically reduced hospital re-admissions and emergency room visits while significantly improving the health of the community!
