2021 is off to a healthy start! The CFC and the American Heart Association are working together to implement a new health and wellness initiative, further expanding our patient services.

Designed as a comprehensive 12-week educational program, Clinic patients can sign up to learn the techniques necessary to improve health & well-being through proper diet, nutrition, exercise and stress management. Weekly monitoring will allow patients to see their progress and measure success before and after the program. Patients with heart disease, hypertension, obesity and diabetes will benefit from the hands on approach funded by the American Heart Association.

Participants will receive the tools they need to make lasting lifestyle changes, including access to weekly organic produce and cooking classes, exercise instruction and equipment as well as peer-to peer support.

Philip is just one of many patients that have found the Clinic to be a place where his medical and mental health needs are met. Philip's story begins in Philadelphia, PA, where he was born and raised. After attending La Salle University, Philip began working and earning an excellent living in the business world. He began to face a huge amount of stress in his job and personal life. In 2016, Philip, unfortunately, lost his job and relocated to Florida. Without health insurance, Philip was unable to take care of his growing medical problems and struggled to maintain good health. In 2018, Philip was referred by a local hospital to the Clearwater Free Clinic, where he began his journey back to a healthy life. Philip had several serious problems, including a detached retina, high blood pressure, sleep apnea, stomach issues, and depression. The Clinic's medical staff went to work and addressed each of Philip's medical needs. Philip was also directed to the Clinic Behavioral Health staff, who helped him find ways to cope with his emotions. Philip once again faced difficult times last year as the covid crisis eliminated his job with the Philadelphia Phillies here in Clearwater. Not to be deterred, Philip, like many others, found several part-time jobs to keep food on the table and a roof over his head. Philip is currently applying for fulltime work and hopes Major League Baseball resumes in the spring! Philip does not hesitate to give the Clinic praise and will tell you that the clinic saved his life.
