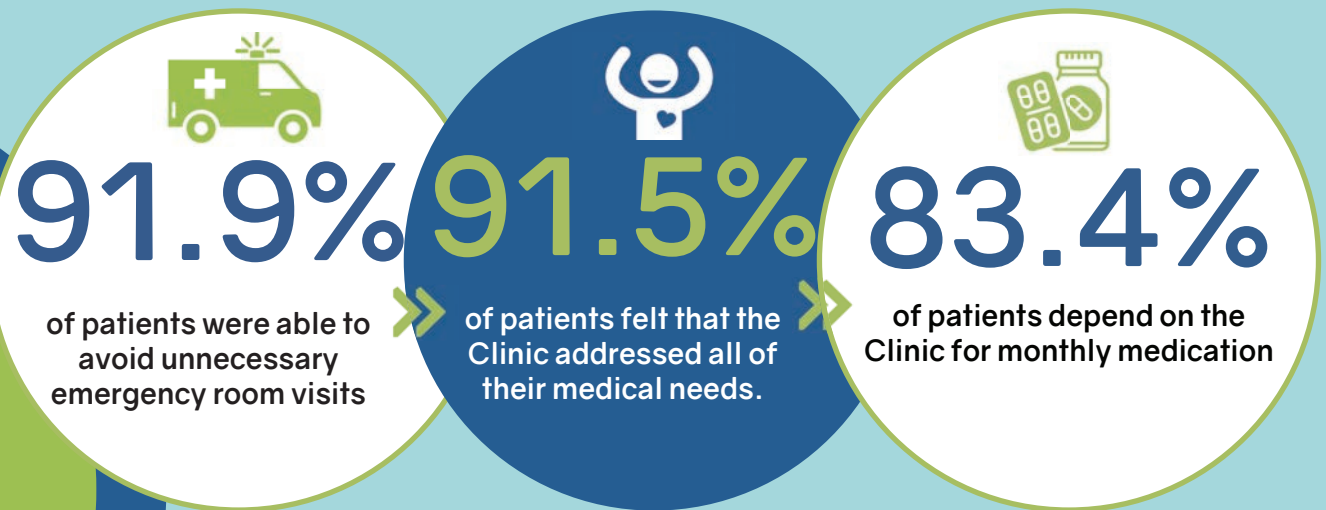

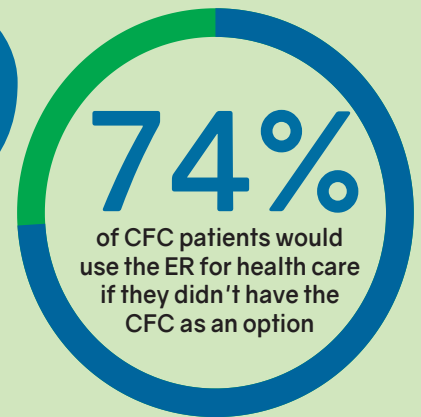

Meet Brian

Brian has been a clinic patient since 2018. At his first visit, he was seen by a CFC volunteer physician who ordered an abdominal ultrasound for complaints of pain after eating.

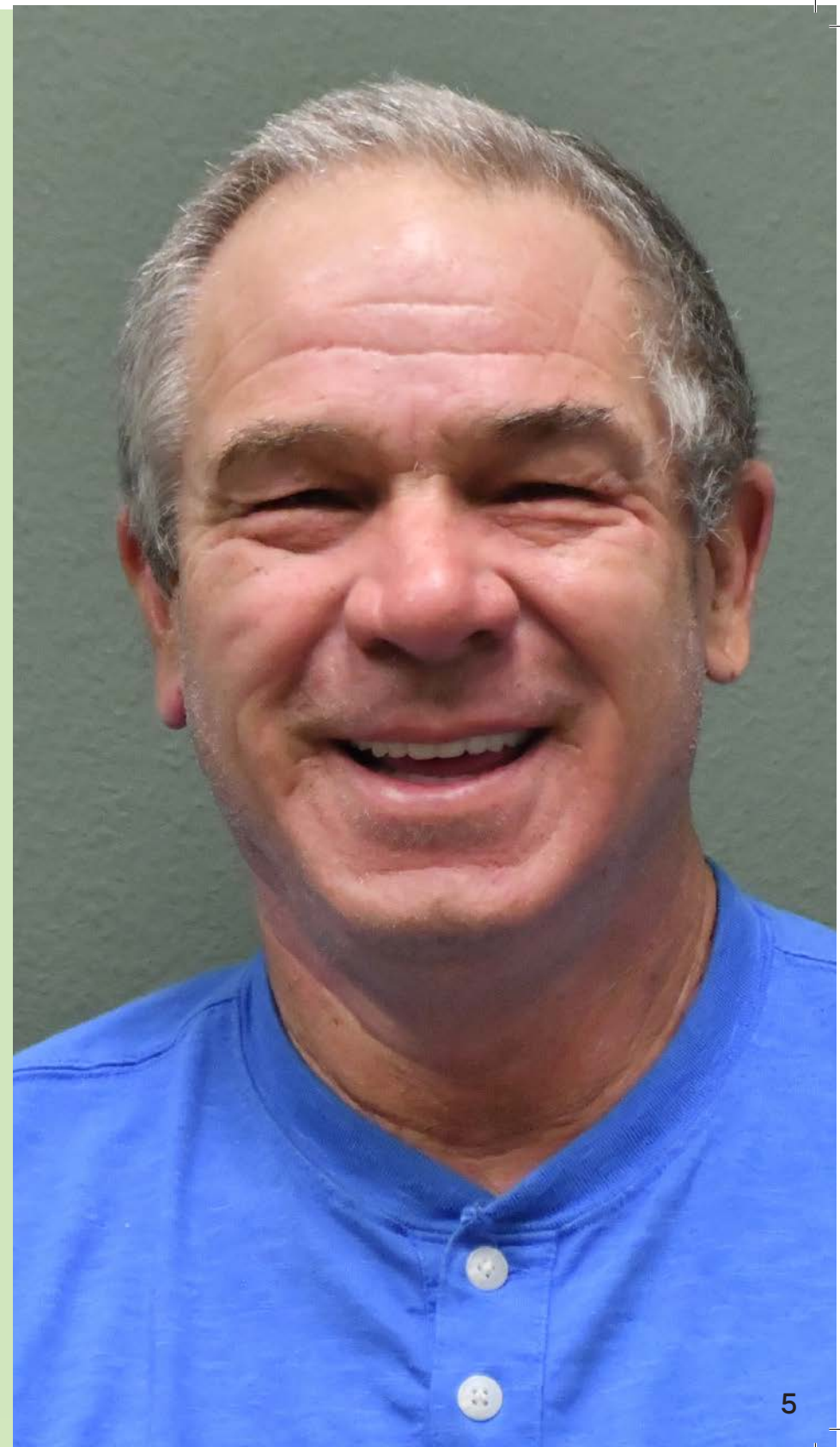
The ultrasound revealed a large pancreatic duct which required further testing. A CFC Nurse Practitioner (NP) ordered an abdominal CAT scan to examine his biliary ducts.

The CAT scan revealed a number of abnormalities which prompted the Clinic NP to bring Brian back to the Clinic for further evaluation and physical exam. The NP discovered large bilateral hernias during a physical checkup. His leg was pale and had a nearly undetectable pulse. For over five years, Brian had been in debilitating pain, unable to walk long distances, and feared he'd have to wait until he was 65 for any surgical treatment, when he qualified for Medicare.

Thanks to CFC community partnerships, the Clinic NP helped him apply for BayCare financial aid and referred him to vascular surgeon, Dr. Gabriel who restored circulation to his leg. According to Dr. Gabriel this measure "saved his leg and his life." Two months later, after recovering from vascular surgery, Brian underwent hernia repair surgery with Dr. Tirone from Clearwater Surgical Associates.

Brian can now walk and exercise, which is essential for him as a construction worker. He is pain-free and improving in all aspects of his health.

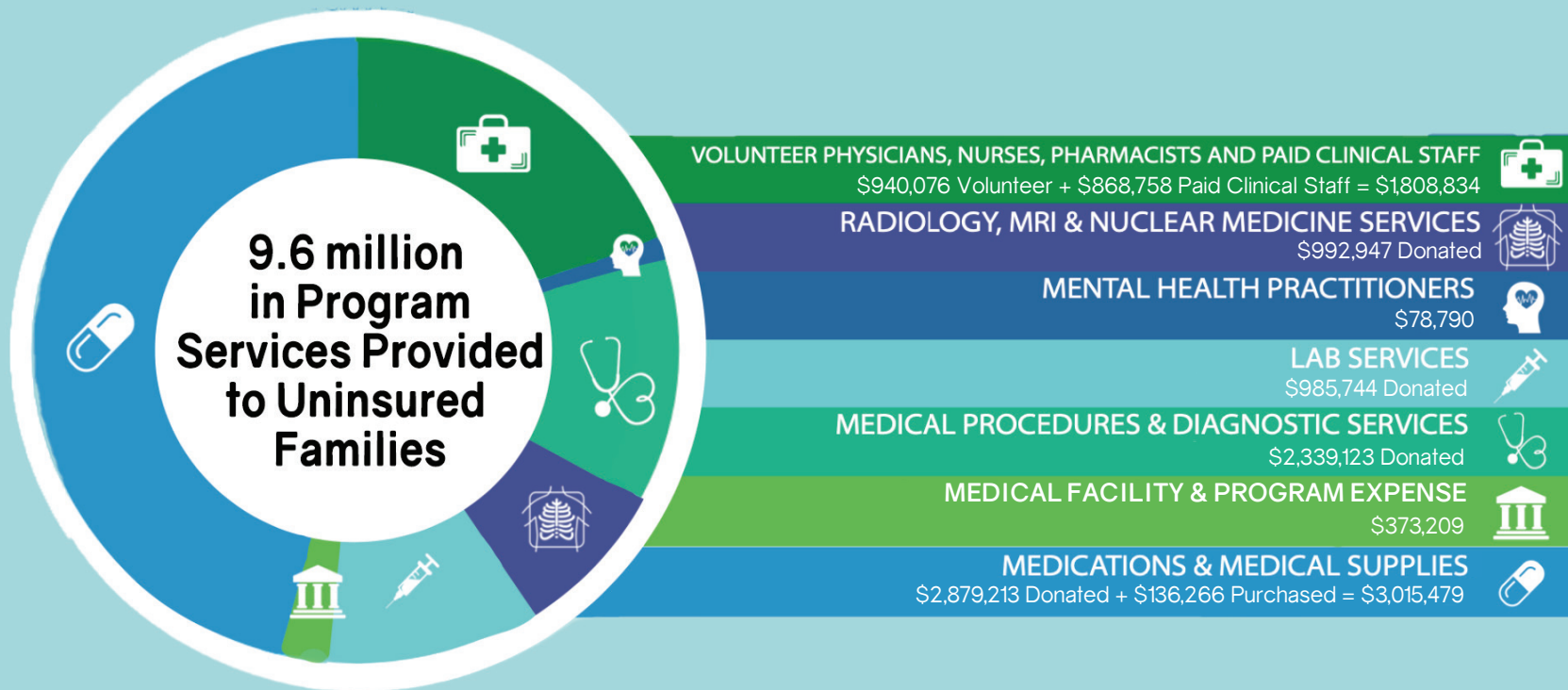

Women's Care

The CFC provides women's care for acute and chronic diseases as well as preventative services. These services include but are not limited to routine PAP smears, clinical breast exams, pelvic exams and ultrasounds, STD testing and treatment, endometrial biopsies, and colposcopies. With the help of our community partners, we are able to refer women for mammograms and surgical management of many gynecological disorders if needed.



Translational Services

The CFC has two translation services, CyraCom and ILA, available to help bridge language barriers between patients and care providers.



Art Connection

The Art Connection, a new program for Behavioral Health patients centered around the use of art as a therapy allows patients to connect with their feelings and experience a sense of self-accomplishment and self-worth while exploring new outlets through the art they complete over an 8 -week period.



Occupational Therapy

Occupational Therapy helps patients develop and recover skills lost due to injury or illness, needed for daily living and work. The Clearwater Free Clinic is grateful to Occupational Therapist, Trina Bellanger, for donating her time to establish this new program and service to our patients.



Meet Shakema

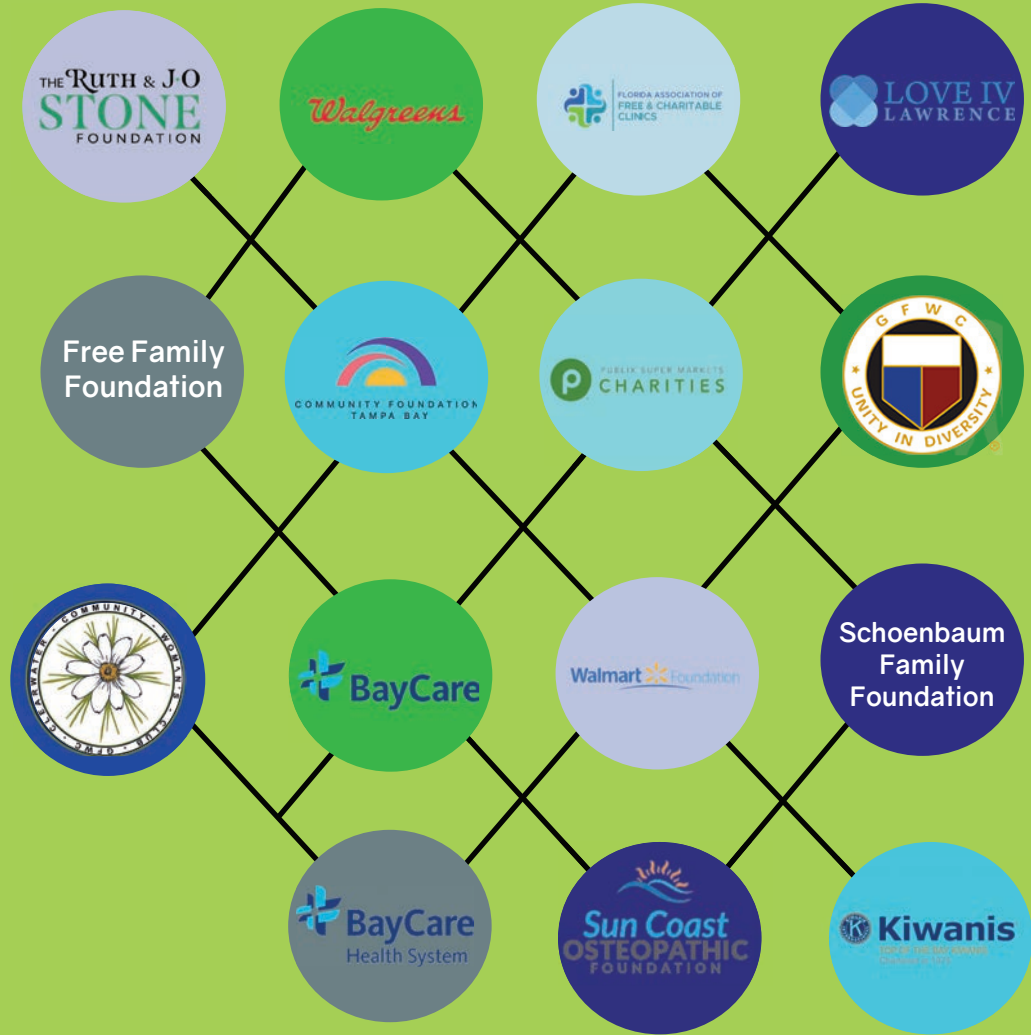
Shakeema became a patient at Clearwater Free Clinic in December 2021 after being hospitalized with uncontrolled hypertension and newly diagnosed with diabetes. She began the Healthy Living Program in January with an average blood glucose level, or A1c, of 9%, a result that indicates diabetes is out of control. Shakeema had a history of heart disease, high blood pressure, high cholesterol levels, and obesity. She was also smoking 7 cigarettes per day.

After working with our Healthy Living Coach, Georgeann, Shakema learned about diabetes and why it is important to control the blood glucose levels to prevent devastating complications caused by the damage that high blood sugar causes to the blood vessels and organs.

With guidance from Georgeann, Shakema began making healthy changes to her diet. Dedicated to getting her health under better control, she attended our smoking cessation class in May and has since quit smoking!

Now that she has maintained her good eating habits and frequent exercise, she has lost nearly 20 pounds and her A1c remains less than 7%! Shakeema says she feels so much better and has more energy now thanks to the Clinic and her personal dedication.

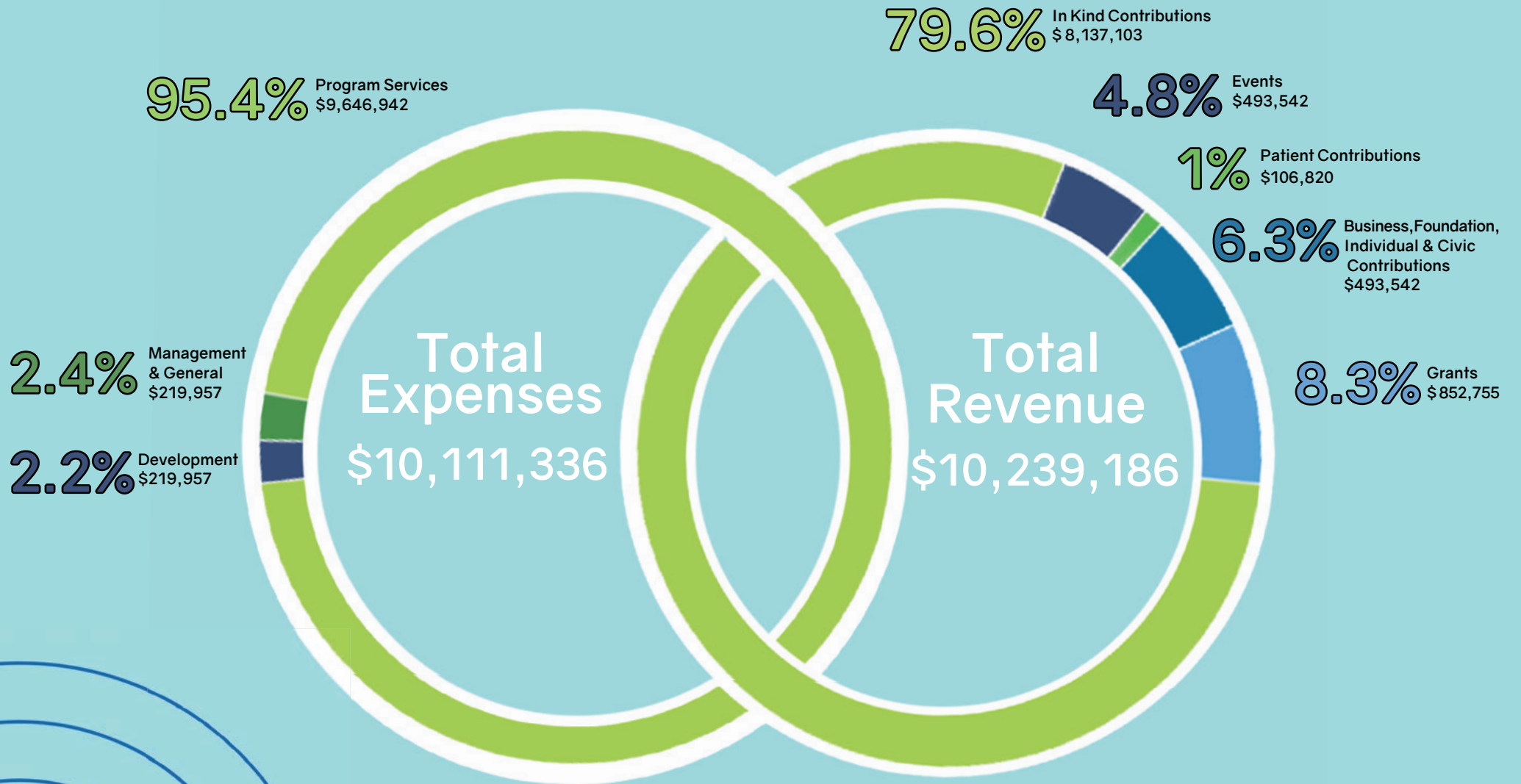

PATIENT NEEDS >> DONOR SOLUTIONS



Continuous positive air pressure (CPAP) machines and lifestyle changes are common sleep apnea treatments. Undiagnosed or untreated sleep apnea increases the risk of sudden death (twice as likely as people without sleep apnea) as well as heart attack, glaucoma, diabetes, cancer, and cognitive and behavioral disorders.

Unfortunately, the high cost of this life-saving equipment, combined with a recent CPAP recall, makes it difficult for Clinic patients to acquire them.

Jim and Sue Petru, committed supporters of the Clinic, were told of the need and generously donated \$10,000 to purchase CPAP machines and also announced an additional \$10,000 challenge match. The CFC immediately began purchasing and distributing CPAPs to patients with the help of BayCare's Sleep Study program. With an additional \$10,000 donation from Chapel by the Sea, the challenge match was met raising over \$30,000 for this essential equipment.

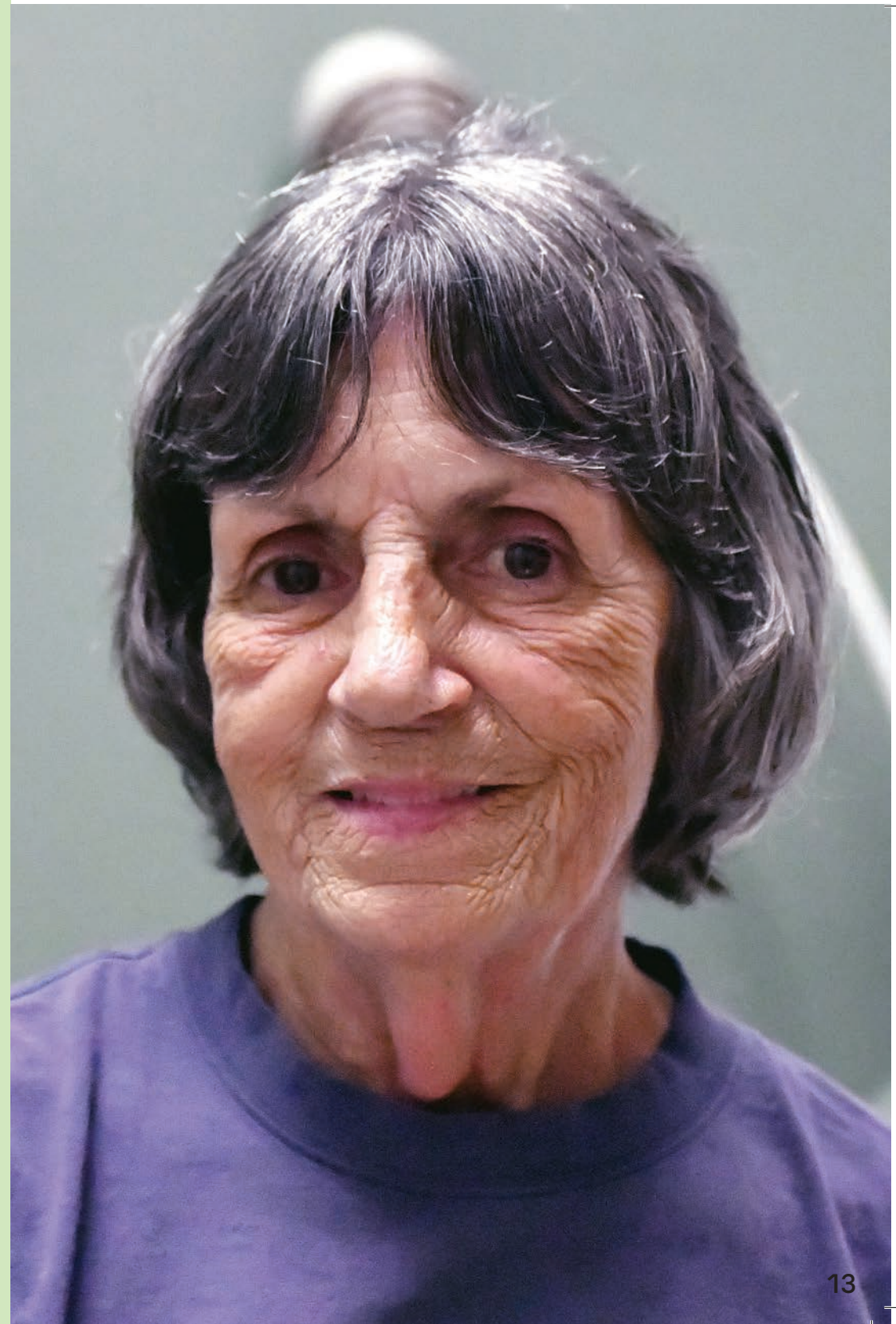
Meet Pat

Pat suffered from many chronic conditions including cardiac disease, hypertension, chronic kidney disease, cervical cancer, and COPD. She was a daily smoker with an 80 pack a year history. Despite urging from her Clinic Nurse Practitioner (NP) provider, Pat chose not to quit smoking however, worried about her lung health because of multiple lung cancer risk factors and a family history. A CAT scan of the chest was ordered and revealed several concerning abnormalities in both lungs, requiring further invasive testing to determine the cause.

The NP referred Pat to Moffitt Cancer Center, a CFC community partner, for further evaluation. Feeling anxious and afraid to confirm her diagnosis Pat delayed her appointment at Moffitt for several months. Ultimately she was evaluated by the Thoracic Oncology Clinic at Moffitt, underwent a resection of her lung mass and was diagnosed with a type of lung cancer called adenocarcinoma. Fortunately, she did not require chemotherapy or radiation after her resection.

Even though she underwent major thoracic surgery at the start of COVID with all of her high-risk conditions, she prevailed despite her long and difficult recovery process. In 2019, Pat quit smoking. She now remains cancer-free and continues to receive follow up chest CTs at Moffitt every 3-6 months. Pat turned 65 and now has Medicare, so she no longer qualifies for Clinic services. However, she continues to be forever grateful for the care she received as a patient of the Clearwater Free Clinic.

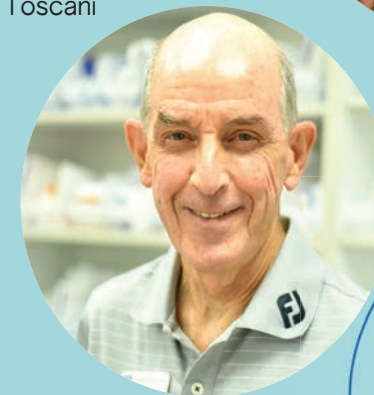

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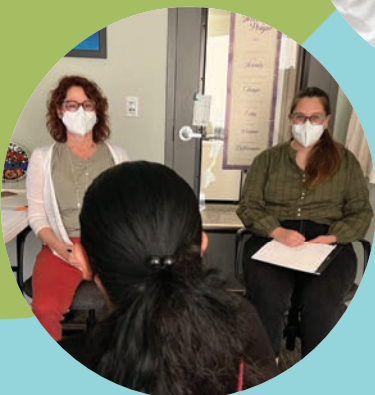
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
