## SMOKE-FREE FUTURE

The Clearwater Free Clinic offers many services to our patients, in addition to clinical and behavioral health care. One of these services is smoking cessation classes. In February, the CFC began another 4-week smoking cessation class taught by Tobacco Free Florida. Patients were able to come for an hour once a week and discuss methods and strategies to quit smoking. To encourage patients to come each week, Tobacco Free Florida provided patients with smoking patches, resources, and fifty dollar Wal-Mart gift cards each week.

"I quit for 8 years, and now I've been smoking again for 4 years. I know that I need to quit smoking to live a longer and healthier life. I am around a lot of people who smoke which makes it harder to quit, but I'm going to keep trying for myself, my kids, and grandkids." -Bonnie, CFC Patient

Many of the patients who attend the smoking cessation class have chronic health conditions that have worsened due to their smoking habits. Over the 4-week period, patients learned about the impact of smoking on the body, especially the lungs, practices and strategies to resist the urge to smoke, and how other patients cope with their smoking habits. The patients appreciated being able to have open discussion with others and set goals for themselves with accountability partners.

### **CLINIC SPOTLIGHT**

## PATIENT STORY: ZIGGY



In 2016 Ziggy Sekula, a former professional Polish soccer player, got in his car and drove to Florida for what he hoped would be a fresh start. After the housing market flipped, Ziggy lost almost all his investments in Chicago and settled in Clearwater without a job or insurance. After discovering he had diabetes, Ziggy could not afford any clinical visits and his health was deteriorating.

A close friend and patient of the Clearwater Free Clinic informed Ziggy of our services and he immediately registered to become a patient. Ziggy came to the CFC with an A1C of 12.0 percent, deteriorating vision, high cholesterol, and low iron. As a former professional soccer player, he relied on the team physician for injuries and minor illnesses but had not seen a doctor in over 35 years. The CFC physicians informed Ziggy his blood sugar had increased because he was no longer as physically active as in prior years as a professional athlete.

Ziggy received monthly medications to lower his cholesterol and increase the iron in his hemoglobin. He was also referred to Blue Ocean Research to receive treatment prevent further

deterioration of his eyesight. Determined to take advantage of the care and support from the CFC, Ziggy took control of his health. Ziggy maintained a healthy diet, got back into the gym, regularly visited the CFC physicians, and lowered his A1C to 5.9 percent.

"I believe if I didn't find out about the Clearwater Free Clinic, I would have never gone to the doctor and seen how bad I was," Ziggy said. "They saved my vision and they saved my life."

Ziggy continues to see our volunteer ophthalmologist for check-ins but he now has his diabetes under control and has a positive outlook on his future.

## **VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT: JYOTI**



Jyoti learned about the Clearwater Free Clinic 15 years ago from a friend who was a volunteer at the time. Having worked in critical care as a nurse for 40 years, Jyoti believed the Clinic provided the perfect opportunity for her to give back.

She faithfully volunteers every Wednesday in intake, supporting our staff by collecting relevant patient information, entering data into our electronic medical records system, and triaging patients. Working in intake allows her to have direct contact with patients and set the atmosphere for a positive patient visit.



"I just want to make sure that the patients feel comfortable at their appointments and answer all the questions that I can for them." Jyoti said.

When Jyoti was a child growing up in India, her dream was to work for Mother Theresa. She has since found ways to live out her dream by supporting local nonprofits and caring for those less fortunate than she. Not only does Jyoti volunteer her services at the Clearwater Free Clinic, but she also helps other local nonprofits in the community, including Big Brother, Big Sister, the Homeless Empowerment Program (HEP), BayCare Alliance, and hospice care facilities.

"Without this free clinic so many people in the community would be in trouble. This place is perfect for meeting the needs of people without insurance," Jyoti said.
